# Ramadan Supplications

*From the book “The Treasures of Success & Happiness” by Shaikh

*“Worship in it is doubly rewarded, and actions are multiplied for their blessings. It is a sunnah to worship in it by standing in prayer and reciting the Qur’an persistently, and by giving much charity (sadaqah) and time for the family, and showing good to relatives and neighbours, in order that we may follow the master of successors, upon him be peace!” (The Treasures of Success & Happiness)*

### To be recited throughout the month

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ، أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ، أَسْأَلُكَ الْجَنَّةَ وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ النَّارِ (x3)،  
اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ عَفُوٌّ كَرِيمٌ تُحِبُّ الْعَفْوَ فَاعْفُ عَنِّي يَا كَرِيمٌ

*"I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, I seek Allah's forgiveness and seek paradise and freedom from the fire (x3), Oh Allah you are pardoning, generous and love to pardon so pardon me oh Generous one!"*

### At Iftar

*Anas ibn Malik narrates that the messenger of Allah said "Not a Muslim exists who fasted and said at the time of breaking it the below except that he was forgiven of his sins like the day he came out of his mother's womb"*

يَا عَظِيمُ يَا عَظِيمُ أَنْتَ إِلَهِي، لَا إِلَهَ غَيْرُكَ، إِغْفِرِ الذَّنْبَ الْعَظِيمَ، فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذَّنْبَ  
الْعَظِيمَ إِلَّا الْعَظِيمُ

*"Oh Great, Oh Great! You are my God, there is no god other than You! Forgive the greatest sins, for none can forgive the great sins except the Great"*

&

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُمْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ وَبِكَ آمَنْتُ وَعَلَيْكَ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَرَحْمَتُكَ رَجَوْتُ وَإِلَيْكَ أَنْبَتُ

*"Oh Allah, for Your sake I fasted and upon Your provision I break it, in You I have believed and upon You I have relied, Your mercy I have hoped for and to You I turn"*

### Note

*The Messenger of Allah, upon him be peace, said "For the one fasting there is a dua at the time of iftar that is always answered". Increase in your duas before opening your fast!*

### Iftar at a Guest's House

*If the Prophet, upon him be peace, was invited to another's house for food upon finishing he would supplicate for the household:*

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَهُمْ فِيْمَا رَزَقْتَهُمْ وَاعْفِرْ لَهُمْ وَارْحَمْهُمْ

*"Oh Allah bless them in what you have provisioned for them, and forgive and have mercy upon them"*

## The Supplication of Obedience to Parents (*Bir al-Walidayn*)

A beautiful supplication recited weekly in Hadramawt and daily in the month of Ramadan. It is a dua for our parents, for their wellbeing and forgiveness and to remember and recall the blessing Allah has endowed us with through them. It is recommended to recite this every night in Ramadan, if not then as often as possible.

## General Recommended Daily Duas

### The Istighfar al-Kabir

The istighfar al-kabir or the dua for the greatest forgiveness was mentioned by the Prophet as being a special dua for seeking God's forgiveness. The knowers of Allah and spiritual educators generally recommended it's recitation three times in the morning and night

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ وَأَنَا عَلَىٰ عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ  
أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَبُوءُ بِذَنْبِي فَاغْفِرْ لِي فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ  
الدُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

*“Oh Allah You are my Lord, there is no god but You, You created me and I am your servant and upon I am faithful to Your covenant and Your promise as much as I can. I seek refuge with You from the evil of what I have done, and I acknowledge before You all the blessings you have bestowed upon me and I confess to You my sins, so forgive me, for truly nobody can forgive sins except You”*

### Prayer upon the Prophet

The prayer on the Prophet carries many rewards and benefits for the reciter. Some of the scholars outlined over 50 benefits of reciting salawat. A famous saying says that the one who has no spiritual guide then the prayer upon the Prophet is his guide. Below is a famous formula for praying upon the Prophet, extracted from the hadith of the Messenger of Allah.

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ عَبْدِكَ وَرَسُولِكَ النَّبِيِّ الْأُمِّيِّ وَعَلَىٰ آلِهِ وَصَحْبِهِ وَسَلَّمَ

*“Oh Allah pray upon our master Muhammad, your servant and messenger, the unlettered Prophet, and upon him family and companions”*
